

CAMP RULES AND PROTOCOLS
BROCKVILLE BRAVES EVALUATION CAMP 2020

All individuals will need to complete an COVID-19 assessment prior to entering the facility.

1. The following individuals are not permitted to participate:
 - i. Anyone who is sick or has any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, headache.
 - ii. Anyone who has recently returned from traveling outside of Canada, in the past 14 days.
 - iii. Anyone who has knowingly been exposed to or been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, in the past 14 days.
2. Change rooms are now open for the purpose of putting on skates only, participants are expected to arrive ready to play and showers remain closed and no access will be permitted. Participants will have access 15 minutes prior to their booking and must vacate the building 10 minutes after their booking. (Change rooms will be sanitized after every rental by staff).
3. Athletes must use their own pre-filled water bottles.
4. Players should sanitize hands when entering the facility.
5. Spectators are not permitted
6. The Lobby Area is restricted to flow through traffic only and parents waiting for athletes are asked to wait in their vehicles.
7. Any person who enters or uses the facility must maintain a physical distance of at least 2 meters from any other person who is using the facility. It is mandatory that all individuals wear a mask in public places to help limit the risk of spread of COVID-19 to others. A mask is not required when on the ice.
8. The Braves agree to take attendance for each date on the contract and for each group accessing the space during the rental period and records must be kept for Thirty days (30) for the purpose of tracing in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak.
9. The Townships COVID-19 Limited Re-Opening Policy and Procedures must be followed at all times, failure to comply will result in immediate removal from the camp and facility.
10. All individuals must comply with all current local Health Unit recommendations and directives related to COVID-19.
